According to classified FBI and CIA documents, Posada is responsible for a series of deadly terrorist attacks: from the 1976 bombing of Cubana flight 455 which killed all 73 on board, to a long string of bombings in Cuban hotels which killed Italian tourist Fabio diCelmo. Posada later boasted about the di-Celmo killing in a New York Times interview. The U.S. refuses to honor Venezuela's request to extradite Posada for the bombing, so Luis Posada Carriles currently remains free.
